


## **Quarterly Update**

RIXML Standards Committee
January 24, 2019

The RIXML organization held its fourth quarterly members' meeting of 2018 at the 60 Wall Street office of Deutsche Bank in New York City. Roman Kitov was the host.

The meeting focused on the planning and implementation of v1.1 of our RIXML Interactions Standard. Deirdre Goldenbogen & Jim Ulrich led the discussion, presented the proposed changes, and reviewed the expected release process.

Call activity was high as we approached year-end. Several calls covered interests in the imminent update to the Interactions Standard, re-visiting the Linkback working group, and distributed ledger technology. We welcome the new year with specific goals on our minds, starting with finalization and production release of Interactions v1.1.
